

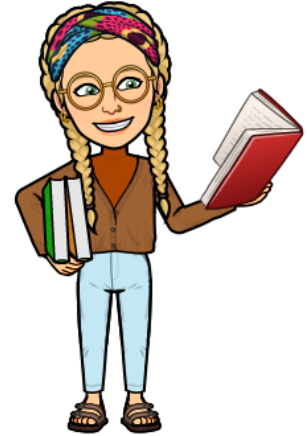
## Summer Reading/IXL Information
